Art, Wine & Wheels to take place May 6 - 8, 2022

Ridgeland, Miss. (April 23, 2022) – The Ridgeland Tourism Commission, city of Ridgeland and MIND Center UMMC announced Art, Wine and Wheels weekend will take place May 6 - 8, 2022, in Ridgeland, Miss., at the open-air Renaissance at Colony Park and along the Natchez Trace Parkway. The weekend includes the Ridgeland Fine Arts Festival hosted by the Ridgeland Tourism Commission, Sante South Wine Festival benefiting the MIND Center UMMC and the Natchez Trace Century Ride hosted and put on by the city.
